

BI-09.02 Emergency Response - Withdrawal of People

(Accountable - Operations Manager (Unassigned))

Expectations

Sites should have documented requirements for withdrawing from hazardous situations including equipment fires.

Specify

Withdrawal of people process cover:

- General requirements
- TARPs and associated training/assessment

All site personnel should be trained in relevant requirements for their work areas.

All TARPs have a condition which requires workers/personnel to withdraw from deteriorating conditions at a location.

Workers and visitors are provided with training to alert them to observations and warnings about a withdrawal requirement.

Any requirement to withdraw is reported and analysed as an incident.

Implement

Trainers and supervisors reinforce the withdrawal requirements of relevant TARPs with workers and visitors.

TARP levels (normally Red) which require a withdrawal are followed and supervisors/workers responsible for areas on site confirm that people have withdrawn.

Monitor

Trainers assess and supervisors regularly confirm workers understanding of withdrawal requirements.

Withdrawal requirements are included in Emergency Drills and reported on and analysed if they occur at other times.
