## CFM-RP-01 Breaches of Statutory Requirements and Regulator

## prosecution

The regulator responds to a mobile equipment fire incident, including response by:

- Ordering operations to cease until changes are made
- Launching enforcement proceedings against the company
- Launching enforcement proceedings against company officers

The consequences for the operating site include a loss of production, legal costs, increased operating costs, representational damage, prosecutions and fines.

This Credible Failure mode is addressed by:
