

CFM 5SD-01 Emergency response is inadequate through lack of skill or equipment

Emergency response is compromised through lack of equipment e.g. unable to quickly release a trapped vehicle operator, caused by:


- Inadequate planning for potential emergency scenarios - equipment not purchased
- Poor logistics or maintenance - equipment not in service

Emergency response is compromised by unavailability of suitably trained and experienced emergency personnel, caused by:

- Inadequate emergency response planning - personnel not hired or trained
- ER personnel not available when requested e.g. minimum numbers for shift emergency response team not met.
- Concurrent emergencies

Credible Failure mode is addressed by:
